

## **TK Professional Development Resources**

New legislation (SB 876) added additional requirements for Transitional Kindergarten (TK) teachers. Here are a few resources to assist TK teachers to meet the new 24 unit ECE requirement:\*

- California Virtual Campus—Searchable online course database. Search California community colleges class offerings using key words: Early Childhood Education or Child Development. Website: https://cvc.edu/
- University of La Verne Courses are designed around the California Learning System which includes Foundations and Framework. The TK certificate is comprised of 6 courses (24 units) delivered fully online. The term for each course is 10 weeks. Cost: \$150.00 per unit (\$600.00 per course, \$3,600.00 for the 24-unit TK certificate.

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★ Brandman University — Earn your child development master teacher permit and qualify to teach TK in as little as 12 months. Fully online, instructor-led, 8-week courses provide students the know-how to build effective environments, interactions and lessons based on the CA Preschool Learning Foundations and Frameworks. Cost: \$525 per course. Website: https://www.brandman.edu/extended-education
